Lodging In Hakuba is at the 4-star [Hakuba Mominoki Hotel](#), located between snow peaks in Hakuba Valley, just a 5-minute drive from Hakuba Station. Amenities include an outdoor hot-spring bath, free Wi-Fi and 3 restaurants.

In Tokyo lodging is at the 4-star [Shinagawa Prince](#), and in Kyoto the hotel is [Kyoto Tokyu](#), both located in the center of the city.
